It is important to understand that I do not encourage the use of negative reinforcement or positive punishment." -Cloe Server

Behavior/Temperament Assessment (\$50.00 per 30-45min session):

A mandatory evaluation to determine behavior and temperament must be scheduled separately prior to any program's first training session.

Problem Solving Program (\$65.00 per 50-minute session):

Effective behavior-problem solving is essential toward creating successful and harmonious dog and owner relationships. Clients will ask for solutions to a wide variety of behavior problems they are experiencing with their dogs. In order to help my clients, there must be an understanding of the basics of problem solving in order to provide a range of solutions. Examples of problem solving include:

- Jumping (excludes "over fences", see Behavior Modification Program below)
- Puppy Nipping and Mouthing
- Unruly Behavior in the House
- Begging
- Stealing Food from Counters
- Excessive Barking
- Inappropriate Chewing
- Coprophagia (Stool Eating)
- Housetraining
- Digging
- Bolting

Treatment Plan Components: Positive reinforcement of alternate behaviors, management of the problem and setting the dog up to succeed, consequences for the problem behaviors, and consistency in dealing with problem behaviors.

<u>Required Training Equipment</u>: To be determined by trainer upon completion of behavior assessment. **Client must have all of the determined items. If requested, Cloé Server will provide them at a cost.**

Behavior Modification Program (\$100.00 per 50-minute session):

Behavior Modification is the elimination, curtailment or management of a complex and sometimes dangerous behavior. Some of these behaviors include dog-on-dog aggression, dog-on-people aggression, separation anxiety, phobias, and compulsive disorders. The treatment plan for these types of challenges generally requires an advanced amount of knowledge and skill, and often the input of a qualified veterinarian. The following will be the focus of establishing better behavior and health:

- Canine Communication
- Leadership Skills
- Physical and Mental Stimulation

Treatment Plan Components: Positive reinforcement of alternate behaviors, management of the problem and setting the dog up to succeed, consequences for the problem behaviors, and consistency in dealing with problem behaviors.
